GENERAL INFORMATION

Entries will be limited to 5 TDX entries. ***The 1st track will be designated in a special draw for those workers having certificates of prior WSOTC work per AKC & WSOTC procedures.*** Entries will be accepted until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. If entry limits are exceeded, a drawing will be held on **WEDNESDAY, November 24, 2021 at 6:30 PM**, at the Secretary's home, to determine which entries will participate. The drawing shall be completely random. However, preference for entry in the TDX test will be given to those dogs that have not yet earned an AKC TDX title. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. Alternates, based on the Catalog order, who are present at the test site at the time of the Track drawing, will be used to replace absent dogs.

Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees shortly after the test. WSOTC will also refund the entry fees to any confirmed entrant who does not participate in the test provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the Day of the Test and provided an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS will be by phone, mailed or emailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries if the address is included in the entry. The Secretary will respond to email requests to confirm that entries are received.

Please make sure all information is readable on your entry form! AKC Titles ONLY.

TDX TEST

All TDX entries must have passed an AKC TD or TDU test. Confirmed entries for the TDX test must be at the Test HQ by 10:00 AM, Sunday, December 5, 2021 at which time there will be a drawing for tracks for each dog entered. As this is a working farm, please **DO NOT** arrive earlier than 9:30am. For those who do arrive in the area before 9:30, there is a Starbucks 5 miles from the HQ at 9660 Old Hwy 99 North Rd C, Burlington, WA 98233. In the event of any absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

Field cover: Field grass, fencing, dirt/gravel roads, ditches, dirt/corn stubble (or another crop). Water may be present.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate subject to the provision set forth in Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations, effective February 1, 1998.

REFRESHMENTS will NOT be provided. See COVID Special Rules for details.

PRIZES: A plaque with the dog's track will be offered to all dogs passing this test.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE:

From South: I-5 North to exit 231 - Chuckanut Drive. Navigate carefully through roundabouts – following signs to northbound Chuckanut Dr. (Hwy 11). (You should end up heading north on west side of I-5) Go about 5 miles turn RIGHT on Sunset. At stop sign turn RIGHT on Worline. Chuckanut Farm is the first dairy on the right. Look for brown building and sheep in field. Please park in brown building's lot – not on the road. From North: I-5 to Exit 236 - Bow Hill Rd. Exit. Turn RIGHT (west) at stop sign. Go about 1.5 miles and turn LEFT on Ershig. Go down the hill and over railroad tracks. Turn RIGHT on Worline. Chuckanut Farm is the second dairy on the left. Look for brown building and sheep in field. Please park in brown building's lot – not on the road. From Whidbey Island: From Hwy 20, turn LEFT on Farm To Market Rd. Turn RIGHT on Sunset. Cross Chuckanut Dr. At next stop sign turn RIGHT on Worline Rd. Chuckanut Farm is the first dairy on the right. Look for brown building and sheep in field. Please park in brown building's lot – not on the road.

Cancellation of Event may occur due to extreme hazardous weather conditions as determined by the Tracking Committee and Judges.

WSOTC SPECIAL RULES FOR COVID-19

WSOTC requires all event attendees to comply with all aspects of these special rules to minimize the risk of COVID-19 spread. The safety of all in attendance is our topmost priority.

1. All attendees are required to bring and wear face masks that cover the nose and mouth.
2. All attendees are required to wear their face mask whenever they are indoors or outdoors within 6' of any other person not from their own household. This includes when they are exercising their dog and whenever they are standing or walking where others may come near them.
 - a. If in doubt, wear your mask.
 - b. There are no exceptions by mutual consent.
 - c. People who are unable to wear a mask due to health reasons must inform the Club with their entry and when they arrive on the grounds. They must maintain the 6' social distance at all times and are strongly encouraged to wear a face shield.
3. Everyone present must sign the waiver provided attesting that they are NOT experiencing any symptoms attributable to COVID-19, and that, to the best of their knowledge, they do not currently have COVID-19, nor have they been in contact with, or exposed to any known carrier within the past 14 days, and they are not waiting for results from a COVID-19 test.
4. All attendees must park safari from other vehicles as the parking lot allows. Please follow any instructions.
5. Attendees are asked to stay in their vehicles as much as possible except when at the draw, being tested, exercising their dog, or working for the event.
6. **NO SPECTATORS.**
7. No congregating closer than 6' with people outside your household in the parking areas or elsewhere.
8. Competitors should bring their own hand sanitizer and disinfecting wipes. There will be a restroom available with disinfectant supplies and you will be asked to disinfect any area you have touched.
9. There will be no food (hospitality or lunch) provided at this event. Bring your own lunch, snacks, and beverages and consume them in your vehicles. A wide variety of eateries are located about ten minutes from the test site.
10. If you feel sick, have any of the COVID-19 symptoms, or been in contact with any known carrier of COVID-19, DO NOT COME. Email the secretary for a full refund. If you start to feel sick while at the event, please leave and then email the secretary for a full refund. Refunds will be by mail.

WSOTC General Event Operational Guidance

1. Follow the rules above. You may be asked to leave the event if you fail to follow the rules.
2. Avoid touching dogs who are not your responsibility.
3. We will hold the test draw while maintaining 6' social distancing.
4. Awards will be presented while maintaining 6' social distancing.
5. In order to limit the numbers of people we ask that you do not arrive prior to 9:30 am.

All requirements of the Washington State Agricultural Event Guidelines, the AKC Tracking Guidance for COVID-19, and CDC recommendations will be adhered to.

I am not awaiting results of a recent COVID-19 test. I have not had a positive COVID-19 test for active virus in the past 14 days nor have I been told to self-monitor, self-isolate, or self-quarantine in the past 14 days.

I agree that I am attending the WSOTC tracking test entirely at my own risk and take full responsibility for my own health and safety during this event.

I fully submit that AKC, WSOTC, Chuckanut Farms and associated individuals are in no way liable for and present or future COVID-19 exposure incurred at any time by any person, in attendance or not in attendance during or after this event, and hereby waive all rights to file a lawsuit against any of the above if I am exposed to COVID-19.
