This Event is Accepting Entries for All American Dogs/Mixed Breed Listed in the AKC Canine Partners Program.

Entries Limited to 2 TD and 4 TDX - CLOSING DATE 11/22/22 AT 4:00 PM PST.

ENTRY FEES: TD - \$65.00 TDX—\$125.00 (includes \$.50 AKC recording fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee) Fees must accompany all entries. A dog may be entered in only one of these two tests, TD or TDX.

This is a “combined test,” therefore if one of the tests does not fill, the AKC’s Tracking Regulations, Chapter 1, sec. 17a: “Combined Tests exchange policy” may be used.

- Make checks payable to Washington State Obedience Training Club (WSOTC) “US funds”
- Express mail entries must include signature waiver.
- No Fax, Email or any other electronic entries will be accepted.
- A \$30 fee will be charged for any returned check
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry
- Fees must accompany all entries.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Entries will be limited to 2 TD & 4 TDX entries. Entries will be accepted until the official closing date, even though the advertised limit has been reached. If entry limits are exceeded, **a drawing will be held on TUESDAY, November 22, 2022, at 6:30 PM, at the Secretary’s home, to determine which entries will participate.**

TEST WORKER OPTION: At the Draw for Participants, 2 Tracks will be set aside as per Chapter 1, Sec. 17d. Please put “Test Worker” at the top of your entry and include your Worker Certificate. The drawing shall be completely random. However, preference for entry in the TD will be for dogs that have not received a TD title and in the TDX for dogs that have not yet earned an AKC TDX title. When the advertised limit has been drawn, all remaining entries, subject to the same preferences set forth in the preceding paragraph, shall be assigned a position on an alternate list corresponding to the order in which they are drawn. Alternates, based on the Catalog order, who are present at the test site at the time of the Track drawing, will be used to replace absent dogs.

Alternates not used will receive full refund of entry fees shortly after the test. WSOTC will also refund the entry fees to any confirmed entrant who does not participate in the test provided that the Test Secretary is notified prior to the Day of the Test and provided an alternate entry participates in the test as a result of the withdrawal.

ACKNOWLEDGEMENTS will be by phone, mailed or emailed by the Test Secretary after the closing of entries if the address is included in the entry. The Secretary will respond to email requests to confirm that entries are received. Please allow 48 hours as per Chapter 1, Sec. 17. Please notify the secretary if you have not received anything after 48 hours.

Please make sure all information is readable on your entry form! AKC Titles ONLY.

In order to limit the number of people and cars at test headquarters, we ask that TD exhibitors do not arrive prior to 7:30 and leave once they receive their award. TDX entrants, please do not arrive prior to 9:30 am. Please park where instructed.

TD TEST:

All TD entries must send an AKC Tracking Certification with their entry, See Chapter 3, Sec. 2. Confirmed entries for the TD test must be at the Test HQ by 8:00 AM, Sunday, December 4, 2022, at which time there will be a drawing for tracks for each dog entered. As this is a working farm, please **DO NOT** arrive earlier than 7:30am. For those who do arrive in the area before 730, there is a Starbucks 5 miles from the HQ at 9660 Old Hwy 99 North Rd C, Burlington, WA 98233. In the event of any absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

TDX TEST:

All TDX entries must have passed an AKC TD or TDU test. Confirmed entries for the TDX test must be at the Test HQ by 10:00 AM, Sunday, December 4, 2022, at which time there will be a drawing for tracks for each dog entered. As this is a working farm, please **DO NOT** arrive earlier than 9:30am. In the event of any absentees among the confirmed entries, the next alternate in catalog order who is present will be allowed to fill the vacancy.

Field cover: Field grass, fencing, dirt/gravel roads, ditches, dirt/corn stubble (or another crop). Water may be present.

BITCHES IN SEASON may participate subject to the provision set forth in Chapter 2, Section 8 of the AKC Tracking Regulations, effective February 1, 1998. The Test Secretary must be notified that a bitch is in season prior to the drawing for tracks. The dog will be given the last track and will not be allowed in the tracking area until just prior to running her track. In the case of more than one bitch in season at the test, a second draw for the last tracks will be held immediately after the first draw.

REFRESHMENTS will NOT be provided.

PRIZES: A plaque with the dog's track will be offered to all dogs passing this test.

By their presence at the Sites, all exhibitors and spectators agree to abide by AKC Rules and Regulations and to follow the instructions of the Tracking Test Committee and Judges. While all care will be taken to insure the safety of both people and dogs, the Washington State Obedience Training Club, the Tracking Test Committee, the landowners, their employees and their agents assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any dog, person, or property on the Sites, or loss, damage or injury to and do, person or property traveling to or from the Sites.

ALL DOGS WILL BE KEPT ON LEASH AT ALL TIMES IN ANY AREA OF THE TRACKING SITES. Owners are responsible for picking up after their dogs and keeping the Sites clean.

DIRECTIONS TO THE SITE:

From South: I-5 North to exit 231 - Chuckanut Drive. Navigate carefully through roundabouts – following signs to northbound Chuckanut Dr. (Hwy 11). (You should end up heading north on west side of I-5) Go about 5 miles turn RIGHT on Sunset. At stop sign turn RIGHT on Worline.

Chuckanut Farm is the first dairy on the right. Look for brown building and sheep in field. Please Park in brown building's lot – not on the road. From North: I-5 to Exit 236 - Bow Hill Rd. Exit. Turn RIGHT (west) at stop sign. Go about 1.5 miles and turn LEFT on Ershig. Go down the hill and over railroad tracks. Turn RIGHT on Worline. Chuckanut Farm is the second dairy on the left.

Look for brown building and sheep in field. Please Park in brown building's lot – not on the road.

From Whidbey Island: From Hwy 20, turn LEFT on Farm To Market Rd. Turn RIGHT on Sunset. Cross Chuckanut Dr. At next stop sign turn RIGHT on Worline Rd. Chuckanut Farm is the first dairy on the right. Look for brown building and sheep in field. Please Park in brown building's lot – not on the road.

Cancellation of Event may occur due to extreme hazardous weather conditions as determined by the Tracking Committee and Judges.
